### **Parade Entry Information**

Welcome to the Twin Cities Juneteenth Parade & Festival. One of Minnesota's most honored traditions and one of the oldest and largest events of its kind.

- To ensure that the full parade experience is enjoyed. Read all of these pages carefully.

- Please review this document and pay close attention to the deadline and meeting dates.
- On parade day, it is important to have everything you need.
- If you are prepared, you will not have to worry about being told at the last minute that what you have arranged does not meet guideline.

The following guidelines are designed to make the parade safe, enjoyable and entertaining for all.

#### Themes:

This year Twin Cities Juneteenth (TCJ) Parade & festival is celebrating with the theme of "2017 creating the future. TCJ will be celebrating Juneteenth. We celebrate the vitality of the communities, express our freedom, and learn from our past to celebrate the future. We ask that you think about the theme and how you can relate it to your entry or organization.

#### General Rules:

1. All entries should be decorated or costumed and relate to the theme of the parade.
2. All entries, (except bands) must have their theme visible to the streets.
3. This is an "all forward motion" parade. Performing groups should choreograph routine to maintain forward movement at the parade pace. No slow cadences allowed
4. All entrants must conform to the description stated on their application. Any changes must be submitted for approval in writing, with a copy of your application. No changes will be allowed after June 1, 2017. The parade Committee reserves the right to re classify applicants.
5. All amplification system must be noted on the application and approved by the parade committee.
6. LIMITATIONS: Only one entry is permitted. ALL ENTRIES ARE PROHIBITED FROM PASSING OUT ANY WRITTEN MATERIALS, SUCH AS, PAMPHLES, LEAFLETS OR FLYERS. Also, no candy or treats to be passed out.
7. Parade order will be mailed approximately June 1, 2017. You will be sent a parade route map, your unit assignment, your parade number, and staging time. Please arrange to communicate this to your group prior to parade day.
8. All entrants will be checked before entering the parade line. At check-in, any entry which does not conform to this application or these rules will be dis-qualified and removed from the parade. All entrance fees will be forfeit. Entries depicting violence, drugs, illegal activities, or otherwise deemed inappropriate will be disqualified and will not be allowed into the line-up. All entrance fees will be forfeited.

Your signature on the parade entry form is evidence that you agree to abide by the rules and decisions of the parade committee, and further, your signature on the entry form indicates that you agree that the Twin Cities Juneteenth Parade & Festival, its Parade Committee, the

City of Minneapolis, and their associates, employees and agent released from any and all liabilities for loss, damage, or injury to any person(s) or property relating in any way to participation in the parade & festival.

#### Safety Rules for All

1. Parade participants may not throw any items from their unit! Costumed out-walkers may distribute appropriate items such as product samples to the audience at the curb, but should not encourage the audience to leave the curb or enter the street. NOTE:

#### DISTRIBUTION OR WRITEN MATERIALS NOT PERMITTED

2. Parade participants may not jump onto or off moving in lane not interfere with any other unit in the parade.

3. Alcoholic beverages are forbidden on, or on the person of any participant. Participant consuming alcohol prior to or during the event will be removed from the line-up.
